

BEST DRESSED: One team will be chosen as Best Dressed Team from photos taken for each of the following categories: TEAMS, SINGLES, DOUBLES and MIXED TRIPLES. Judging will take place after the Tournament by the NDA's Team Dart Tournament Committee. Teams will be judged on: appearance, innovation and creativity.

ONSITE ALTERNATE RULE (APPLIES AFTER MARCH 12):

Onsite alternates can be used by a team as long as the Tournament Committee has approved the change 2 hours prior to the day's event. An alternate must be from the same league system and meet all the player requirements noted in Player/Team Eligibility. Alternate players must be rated equal to or less than the player they are replacing. It is recommended that possible alternates be submitted, with their statistics, prior to the tournament by your operator to avoid delays. Onsite approval for alternates not already participating in the tournament can be requested by a Charter Holder, with appropriate league statistics, within the time frame noted. For ladies and mixed events, the alternate player must also be of the same gender. No roster changes are allowed in finals. Absolutely no one can serve as an alternate on more than one team per event. Any players on your team roster for that event may be rotated in match-by-match, not between games.

Singles and Doubles Notes: Players may participate in both Cricket and 501 events. All events are open, with the exception of the Ladies Masters events.

Mixed Triples Notes: The Mixed Triples events <u>do not</u> interfere with any other event. Team must include at least one female.

Mixed Doubles Combo Notes: The event will include both Cricket and 501 games. Team must consist of one male and one female.

LADIES TEAM NOTES: Ladies may choose to play in Open or Ladies Masters for Team Cricket and Team 501. There is no separate Ladies division.

Player Eligibility

1. All tournament players must:

- A. Be sanctioned by the National Dart Association for the 2009-2010 membership year.
- B. **Play in leagues ran by National Dart Association Charter Holder** members in good standing and that are in compliance with all league-sanctioning guidelines. (Only league systems that have every player sanctioned are considered sanctioned leagues.)
- C. Have played a minimum of 96 league games between April 1, 2009 and March 5, 2010. Qualifying games must be obtained in no less than eight (8) separate weeks of league play. [League games can consist of '01 and/or Cricket with a minimum of 24 games in the format the player is entering ('01 or Cricket).]
- D. Compete during regular league play on machines owned and operated by National Dart Association Charter Holder members.
- E. Be entered in the tournament by the National Dart Association Charter Holder on whose machine(s) they have completed the minimum game requirements for tournament entry.
- F. Have a National Dart Association Player-skill rating using the Points Per Dart (PPD) and/or Marks Per Round (MPR) performance rating system for the event in which they are entered, to be classified. These performance ratings require a player to compete in 24 games in a single season for that event. Minimum time to obtain a Player-skill rating is eight (8) separate league nights in eight (8) different weeks. Players without a valid PPD or MPR will be classified as a Master-rated player and the Charter Holder will be billed for a Master entry. (See Player Classification and Documentation Requirements for additional details.)
- G. Not compete in more than one level (Open, Ladies and Masters) in any one event.
- H. **Be at least 18 years of age** and comply with the regulations of local, state and federal laws in which they compete in leagues. Prize checks can only be cashed onsite for those over 21 years of age.

2. All tournament teams must:

- A. Choose to compete in open or ladies but cannot compete in both for a single event.
- B. Declare a full team roster, including substitutes, when certificates are completed.
- C. Must participate in the same league system and have formed a tournament team meeting the following criteria and applying to all events.
 - Each person on the team roster must meet all of the player requirements listed under Player/Team Eligibility.
 - All players must have a minimum of 96 league games from April 1, 2009 to March 5, 2010. (These league games can consist of '01 and/or Cricket, not just the game the tournament team is entering.)

(See Onsite Alternate Rule on page 2 regarding the use of alternates.)

Substitute players for Doubles, Triples and Teams: Teams may use a substitute from within the same league system as long as the substitute player has competed in the same league format as the regular players. Regular team substitutes should be entered on the regular player certificate. Only one substitute per team can be used for the Second Chance Team Cricket event.

VIOLATIONS of the above will void entries and be nonrefundable.

GAME REQUIREMENTS AND PLAYER-SKILL RATING

- - - - - - - - -

Each player entering the tournament must have played a minimum of 96 league games from April 1, 2009 to March 5, 2010.

- - - - - - - - - -

To establish a valid Player-Skill Rating a player must have played at least 24 of their 96 games in the event in which they are entering, <u>and</u> the minimum time to obtain a Player-Skill Rating is eight (8) separate league nights in eight (8) different weeks.

Player Classification and Documentation Requirements

In addition to meeting the eligibility requirements listed previously, players and Charter Holders must also comply with the following (pay particular attention to Master-rated criteria):

- 1. **Minimum game requirements** Each player must play a minimum of 96 league games between April 1, 2009 March 5, 2010.
- 2. All players must be entered with their highest known Player-Skill Rating, league or tournament play, for the qualifying period. This is the responsibility of the Charter Holder. Accuracy of player abilities are dependent upon proper submission and documentation from the Charter Holder. All Charter Holder members are bound by the Code of Ethics of the National Dart Association. (Individual Player Skills from Team Dart XXIV are included.)
- 3. The highest known Player-Skill Rating is determined by taking the highest player skill (PPD/MPR) rating from a league season for the qualifying period of April 1, 2009 March 5, 2010, including the current league season (remember that this must be a minimum of 24 games in no less than eight (8) weeks of league play).

For example, Pete played in the following leagues for Acme Vending:

Spring 2009 ending May 15	PPD 24.50
Summer 2009 ending August 30	PPD 23.50
Fall 2009 ending December 15	PPD 25.50
Spring 2010 in play with 24 games over	
four weeks at time of submission	PPD 25.75

The highest known Player-Skill Rating for this player for tournament entry would be the 25.75 PPD from the Spring 2008 season currently in session. If Pete had competed in Team Dart XXIV and had a <u>higher</u> Player-Skill Rating from that event, the Team Dart XXIV performance would be his highest known Player-Skill Rating. *When providing player skills, the figure should be carried out two digits past the decimal.*

- 4. The Charter Holder will be required to send the following documentation to the NDA prior to March 5, 2010:
 - A. Documentation that each player entered has played the required 96 games.
 - B. Documentation of the highest known Player-Skill Rating for each player entered.

This documentation can include league standing sheets with the entered players highlighted.

5. **Standardized league results are the only accepted statistics.** All recorded Player-Skill Ratings are achieved using the actual darts thrown. In addition, the following are standard formats for game play to calculate a Player-Skill Rating:

<u>01</u>
Open In/Open Out format
8-foot foul line
15 1/2" target face
Full 50-point bull's-eye

<u>Cricket</u> 8-foot foul line 15 1/2" target face Split 50/25-point bull's-eye

DETERMINING PLAYER-SKILL RATING

Each player must be entered with their HIGHEST KNOWN Player-Skill Rating.

This is determined by taking the highest <u>end of season</u> PPD and/or MPR average from those seasons in which the player has participated.

.

The player must have played at least 24 games of the event they are entering in no less than eight (8) weeks of league play to determine a skill rating for the season.

A minimum of 96 games must be played from April 1, 2009 to March 5, 2010.

- - - - - - -

Double In/Double Out (DI/DO) statistics will automatically force players into Masters events.

Player Classification and Documentation Requirements continued

6. Player ability assessment may be determined by the tournament committee by any of the following criteria:

- A. Player-Skill Rating (as described previously).
- B. Review of previous NDA tournament performance, specifically Team Dart XXIV.
- C. Examination of overall local league ratings.
- D. Known ability.

All decisions of the Tournament Committee are final.

7. Master-rated criteria:

A. Players with the following Player-Skill Ratings or above will be considered Masters in their respective events:

B. Master rating may also be awarded to players who:

- 1. Are without a verifiable player-skill rating (e.g. Double In/Double Out statistics). *These players will play in Masters only.*
- 2. Placed in the money in an NDA's Masters' level event in the last year.
- 3. Show "known ability" by top placement in an NDA manufacturer sponsor's major tournament. *Pro lists will be reviewed, but not automatically forced into Masters.*
- 4. Are "Dominant Players" in either soft or steel-tip darting.
- C. No master-rated player will be permitted to participate below level one.

D. Two master-rated players on ANY team must play at the Master's level.

- E. For Mixed Doubles Combo, both the Open Cricket and '01 player rating will be used to determine master-rated players. For Mixed Triples 701, the Open '01 criteria will be used to determine master-rated players (see above).
- F. Ladies playing in a non-ladies masters event (singles, doubles, mixed doubles or team) should use the open criteria to determine master's player ratings.

Frequently Asked Questions

For full eligibility details or questions visit the NDA Web site at www.ndadarts.com or call your local NDA operator.

Who can play on my team?

Any sanctioned player from **any of your Charter Holder's leagues** who has completed 96 league games with qualifying statistics is eligible to play on your team. <u>YOU CANNOT PLAY WITH SOMEONE FROM ANOTHER</u> CHARTER HOLDER.

- Mixed Triples teams must have at least one woman on each team
- Mixed Doubles Combo teams must consist of one woman & one man.

If one of my team members can't come to the tournament at the last minute, can anyone substitute for that player at the tournament?

No, not just anyone. After March 12 all changes and substitutions must be made at the tournament and must meet the following criteria:

- Alternate must be from the same league system.
- Alternate must meet all eligibility requirements with stats on file on-site.
- Alternate's skill rating must be LESS THAN or EQUAL TO the player they are replacing.
- In ladies or mixed events, the alternate must be of the same gender.
- NO ALTERNATES PERMITTED IN THE FINALS.

How do I know if I'm a Master-rated player?

Master-rated criteria is as follows:

Players with the following Player Skill Ratings or above will be considered Masters in their respective events:

Master rating may also be awarded to players who:

- 1. Are without a verifiable player skill rating (these players will play in masters only).
- 2. Placed in the money in an NDA's master's level event in the last year.
- 3. Show "known ability" by placement in an NDA manufacturer sponsor's major tournament.
- 4. Are "Dominant Players" in either soft or steel-tip darting.

No Master-rated player will be permitted to participate below level one. Two Master-rated players on ANY team must play at the Masters' level. For Mixed Doubles Combo, the open Cricket and '01 rating will be used to determine master rated players. For Mixed Triples 701, the open criteria will be used to determine Master-rated players.

• Note: Ladies playing in a non-ladies masters event (singles, doubles, mixed doubles or team) should use the open criteria to determine master's player ratings.





Open and Masters Mixed Doubles 501


Team Dart's newest events are Open Mixed Doubles 501 and Masters Mixed Doubles 501:

- EVENT: Thursday, April 22, 2010 at 5:00 PM
- **SIGN-UP:** Pre-registration required via the Web or by sending in the Official Tournament Entry Form.
- **FORMAT:** Double elimination, best two out of three.
- FEES:\$72 for Open
(\$54 per team per event + a \$18 administrative fee.)

\$126 for Masters (\$108 per team + a \$18 administrative fee.)

NOTE: Team must have one female.







Open Senior Singles Combo

Allows players **50 years or older** to compete in a leveled event specifically for them. *No Masters allowed.*

NOTE: If you are registered for Senior Singles Combo and make it to the Finals of Open Team Cricket, there will be a conflict in play. Entry fees will be refunded in full for Senior Singles Combo if this occurs.

- Have played a minimum of 96 league games with their NDA operator between April 1, 2009 and March 5, 2009 and meet all other Team Dart requirements
- Participate in a minimum of one (1) event for Team Dart XXV in 2010

*Eligibility is contingent on verification of league and 2010 Team Dart XXV participation.

Applicants will receive one (1) entry for each event entered in Team Dart XXV in 2010 and one (1) additional entry for staying at the Riviera during the tournament*. A Doubles Team consists of two individuals from one NDA operator who are participating in Team Dart, but does not have to be the same team in an event at Team Dart.

*Player Card rooms at the Riviera are not applicable due to the NDA not having access to this information.

NDA OPERATOR ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Operators must:

- Be in good standing with the NDA
- Sanction 95% or more of entire league system
- Be accountable for statistics
- Approve team that applies by signing the application
